On an annual basis, The South Atlantic Jubilee awards scholarships to deserving students who are attending a vocational/trade school/certificate program for post-secondary education. The scholarship can be utilized for tuition, books or lab fees.

To file a completed application, it is necessary to follow the steps below, complete the enclosed forms as directed and attach the required items.

ELIGIBILITY: Any properly executed application will be accepted from traditional or home school students. To qualify, the applicant must:

- Be a member, or the child, grandchild, or spouse of an individual member in good standing (membership for a minimum of three years) of one of the JUBILEE state associations. The JUBILEE affiliated states include: Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Maryland/Delaware, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, and West Virginia;
- Be a high school senior, high school graduate, GED graduate, or returning vocational student;
- Maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average during their last two years of formal education. An applicant who has been out of school for more than two years may submit transcripts or no less than two employment related recommendations.

High School Seniors, high school graduate, GED graduate:

- Provide transcripts including cumulative grade point averages for two years; or
- Provide GED transcripts; or
- Provide home school transcripts/home school umbrella program transcripts and Administrator and Accordance Statement (for additional details see: *Instructions for Home School Application*) **or**
- Provide a copy of ACT or SAT scores

Returning Vocational Education and Training (VET), trade school, certificate program students:

Provide last year of Vocation transcripts with at least a pass or fail indicated for course work.

LETTER OF REFERENCE:

• Enclose one letter of reference from non-family individual such as guidance counselor, teacher, or employer.

Eligibility and Application Instructions Continued

• Enclose the essay with the application, **Minimum size: 500 words**.

Content

Respond to the following essay questions:

- Why do you want to continue your education?
- What are your ambitions and goals?
- How will you use your education to benefit your community and the world?
- Include one paragraph on one of the following:
 - How can you use your chosen career or field of study to affect the sustainability of water in the natural environment?
 - How will your career be affected by the availability of water?
 - How can your life choices affect the quality of water in your life?

THE ROLE OF JUBILEE ESSAY:

- **On a separate page**, respond to the following question:
 - What role has the JUBILEE played in your life and the life of your family?

PROCEDURE: The applicant must complete the following application in full and it must be postmarked by Friday, May 31, 2024, to be eligible. Applicants may apply multiple times over subsequent years. However, someone can only receive the scholarship twice.

<u>REVIEW</u>: Eligible applications are reviewed and selected by the Scholarship Committee. Evaluations are based on:

- Academic achievement, grade point average (weighted/non-weighted)
- Honors received
- Quality of the essay
- Community involvement
- Letter of recommendation

DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS: The winning applicants will be notified by June 21, 2024. Scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the financial aid department of the school the applicant is to attend or is attending. The funds must be used in the year the scholarship is awarded.
